

## **Tabernacle of Faith Christian Church Rev. Arriana M. Daniel Scholarship Award Application**

The **Arriana M. Daniel Scholarships** will be awarded to the high school senior(s) and/or current college student(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards are not limited to cover tuition and fees. Award amounts are to be used at the discretion of the Scholarship Recipient in preparation for his/her college or trade school experience.

The Selection Committee will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone or email. The Scholarship Committee may choose to interview applicants to help in their decision. The scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by **June 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year of the amount of the Scholarship being awarded.** Recipients are expected to attend the Graduate Recognition and Scholarship Award Program held at **Tabernacle of Faith Christian Church** on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of June each year to receive their award letter. Award checks will be given once the Recipient(s) provides their college acceptance and date of arrival letter from their college, university, or trade school.

### **Guidelines for the Arriana M. Daniel Scholarship Fund**

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors and students currently enrolled at any accredited college, university, or trade school.. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the award recipient upon proof of acceptance to the educational institution they will attend.

Student applicants must meet the following guidelines:

1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college, university, or trade school on a full time basis.
2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college, university, or trade school of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the fall semester of the current school year.

Student applicants should note any special financial needs on their application form.

**All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than May 22nd of the current school year.**

Please advise your high school/college registrar of this deadline for submission of transcripts and other supporting documentation. Student applicants that have completed one full academic year at a college/university do not need to submit High School transcripts.
